

Stomach Bug Season



The stomach flu, or viral gastroenteritis, is when your stomach and intestines become inflamed and irritated. The stomach flu usually develops after coming into contact with an infected person. Symptoms can include diarrhea, vomiting, stomach pains, mild headache, and muscle aches. These symptoms can last for 3 to 7 days and sometimes up to 10 days. There is no cure for the stomach flu. Fluids, bland foods, and rest can help alleviate the symptoms.

Since the stomach flu is highly contagious, it is important to take extra precautions when flu season comes around. Proper hand washing, disinfecting countertops and surfaces, and staying away from others who are sick will help keep you and your family healthy.

Counselor's Corner

Well... we blinked and it's the holidays! I feel like the older I become, the quicker and quicker life seems to fly by! And groups definitely flew right by this semester! Every fall, I will send home permission forms for students to participate in groups. I offer lunch bunches, anger groups, and worry groups. Students in lunch bunches get to know each other, learn about friendships, and play fun games with each other (and eat lunch at the same time!). Kiddos in anger groups have been learning about feelings, what anger feels like in our bodies and minds, and various coping skills. Worry group is similar in that we learn about how worry feels in our bodies and learn different coping skills. Fall/first semester groups will be wrapping up in the next couple of weeks! In total- I had 59 students in groups this semester!

After winter break, groups will open again with the ability for you to sign your student(s) up! Students cannot participate in the same group that they participated in the first semester (if they were a part of a group). Available spaces are on a first-come, first-served basis. Some groups had a waitlist, so those students will automatically join the second semester groups. However, I will have some room in the following groups: Anger group (Gr 1-3), Worry group (Gr 1-3), Boy's lunch bunch (Gr 2-3). And a few spots left for Girl's lunch bunch (K-1 & 2-3).

If you are interested in getting your student signed up for a group, permission forms will be sent out when school resumes in January. Would love to see your kiddos during groups!
